Mayor Conway called the City Council Meeting of Cresson, Texas to order at 7:00 P.M. June 22, 2021, at the City of Cresson Council Chambers. Attendance as follows:

Citizen's Comments

Citizen Tanya Carden of 133 Brook Drive spoke regarding the road repair. She is not happy with what she calls it being a "dirt road"; stating it is not a good long-term fix and is concerned about loss of property value do to the "dirt road".

Mayor's Comments:

Update on Commissioner's Court Vote-Shared Sheriff Deputy-The Court voted to approve the Shared Deputy this morning with an effective date of July 1, 2021.

Update on Railroad clean up at Hwy 377/171-Had success getting the debris removed from the corner of Hwy 377/171.

Tour of the NoX monitoring trailer for Ozone monitoring- As part of our partnership with the Hood County Clean Air Coalition, we got to tour the new trailer that will be onsite in Granbury through the summer.

Sales Tax update for June-Sales tax was down from last month but still a good amount at \$93,000. We will be providing a trend for a couple of years to show the council to assist in our evaluation of the path forward on the Bob Cornett Park.

Deliberation Agenda:

- A. A discussion regarding the current status of Bob Cornett Park. The City has a possible partnership with a potential developer who would fund outlying costs not covered by the grant. The park will need to be built by September 2022; however the "extras" not covered by the grant do not need to be completed right away. Council will revisit this item at the July 13 meeting for a vote to revitalize the project.
