**Mayor's Report and Comments**

- A. May 6, 2023 Election:** All candidates are running unopposed for places 1, 3, and 5. Place 2 is for a 1-year term since he was appointed to replace Dana Perdue. We still have the election for the 1/2 % sales tax for road maintenance. This renewal is required every 4 years. If you vote no, you are simply saying to give it to Hood County. Early voting is April 24, 2023-May 2, 2023. Dates, times, and locations will be available soon.
- B. Sales Tax Update:** Trending down with January coming in at \$96,790 and February coming in at \$88,960.
- C. New lighted City Hall sign:** Hopefully you've noticed the illuminated sign outside which should help folks find us in the dark and during the day.
- D. Pothole at Hwy 171/377:** This has been reported to TXDOT for the past 3 weeks.

**Deliberation Agenda**

- A. Consider and take any action to approve or disapprove the adoption of Resolution 2023-003 consenting to the addition of approximately 17.918 acres of land to the Municipal Utility District No. 1.**  
There is a correction in the acreage. The approximate acreage is 18.551. Councilperson Clement made a motion to approve the Resolution with the correct acreage. Councilperson Robertson seconds the motion. 3 ayes and 0 nays. The motion passed unanimously.

**B. Consider and take any action to approve or disapprove a shortform replat application received from Carina Aviation for a 1.219-acre tract of land of the Heffington Stephen Survey, Abstract No. 620, City of Cresson, Parker County, Texas.** Councilperson Clement makes a motion to approve the shortform replat. Councilperson Keeney seconds the motion. 3 ayes and 0 nays. The motion passed unanimously.

**C. Approve the minutes from the city council meetings held on January 24, 2023, and February 17, 2023.**

Councilperson Keeney makes a motion to approve the minutes as written. Councilperson Robertson seconds the motion. 3 ayes and 0 nays. The motion is passed unanimously.
