 - 2) The City asks for 50% of the parking to be covered, they want no covered parking
 - 3) The City asks for 75% of the ground floor exterior wall surface to be of brick, stone or combination thereof, or of an equivalent masonry material (hardy board). They want front of the houses brick, rock, or combination thereof. The back of the house hardy board.
 - 4) A traffic impact analysis must accompany the site plan unless the city engineer determines that the analysis is not necessary for the Mult-Family Development. Engineer said that the analysis is not necessary for the Family Development.

Councilmember Becker made a recommendation to the City Council that the variance be granted on subsection 20.5 for 8ft. ceilings instead of the 9ft. ceilings. Upon motion duly made by Councilmember Becker and seconded by Councilmember Farr. 4 ayes and 0 nays. The motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Becker made a recommendation to the City Council that the variance be granted on subsection 20.7 for the front of the houses or any part of the house that faces the street to be brick and rock, and the back of the houses be hardy board. Upon motion duly made by Councilmember Becker and seconded by Councilmember Manley. 3 ayes and 1 nay. The motion passed.
